Dear Mr. Osborne:

This letter serves to confirm the accreditation of Musculoskeletal Transplant Foundation (MTF). The definition of Birth Tissue in the 14<sup>th</sup> Edition of AATB Standards for Tissue Banking (implementation date: January 01, 2017) is as follows:

BIRTH TISSUE – gestational tissue donated at the time of delivery of a living newborn. This includes placenta, Wharton’s jelly, amniotic fluid, chorionic membrane, amniotic membrane, placental/chorionic disc, umbilical veins, and umbilical cord tissue.

The 13<sup>th</sup> Edition of AATB Standards for Tissue Banking was in effect at the time of MTF’s accreditation inspection, where the specific tissues listed above were considered Musculoskeletal Tissue. Activities associated with applicable tissues listed above were reviewed during the AATB inspection, and ultimately MTF was deemed to be operating in compliance with the 13<sup>th</sup> Edition of AATB Standards for Tissue Banking. However, because Birth Tissue standards were not in effect at the time of inspection, accreditation does not reflect Birth Tissue, but instead Musculoskeletal Tissue. Accreditation includes the following:
